We're here to challenge ideas and reinterpret the icons of Baroque and Classical music for the 21st century, creating new audiences to ensure early music lives on in the hearts and minds of new generations.

Reigniting early music from the 16th, 17th and 18th century on period instruments, that is where our faith for tradition begins and ends. Loved for our personality, warmth and spirit, Australia's flagship period orchestra is for the bold explorers who are unsatisfied having their expectations met with the tropes of pomp and predictability.

We're for the wanderers who courageously thirst for something new; for the seekers and searchers who relish in the spirit of international collaboration for which we are known, which continues to spread dee throughout the world, uncovering the freshest talent and genre-bending virtuosos from all corners of the globe.
